Members of the delegation

Executives and leadership staff of public student service organizations in Germany (the STWs) as well as colleagues from comparable institutions in other European countries within the European Council for Student Affairs (ECStA). Participants do not need to be NASPA members.

Costs

Participants pay for their own airfare. Accommodation and conference participation as well as most meals are covered by a participation fee of approx. 1500,00 Euro per person, which will be invoiced before the exchange.

Since Boston is a very expensive city, please calculate additional expenses for occasional dinners, personal expenses and public transportation in Boston.

Languages

Working language of the study visit is American English. A good knowledge of English (level B2) is required. If needed, DSW can provide support with the specific vocabulary and occasionally provide informal consecutive translation in group events.

Registration

The study visit takes place when there are at least five registered persons, and the entire group is limited to a maximum of 15 persons. A waiting list will be opened if there are more registrations than places.

Please make sure to register as soon as possible, please register only one person per institution, and be prepared to be on a waiting list.

After confirmation, NASPA will sign up all participants for the international symposium and the campus tours.

More practical information particularly on travel arrangements, entry conditions, accomodation and a detailed program is sent to the registered participants shortly after the deadline.
