# Studierendenwerke und Studentenwerke: Facts and figures 2023/2024



## Revenues and public subsidies 2 Mrd. € (+ 12%) in 2023

- Revenues 1,2 Mrd. € (+16%)
- Student social contributions 395 Mio. € (+4%)
- Subsidies federal states 196 Mio. € (+6%)
- other subsidies 136 Mio. € (+20%)
- BAföG subsidies 111 Mio. € (+ 3%)

## Catering and dining services

- Turnovers + 36 % from 285 Mio. € up to 387 Mio. €

## Counselling

- Psych. counselling 133.000 (+ 7%)
- social counselling 80.000 (+14%)

## Student Housing

- Residence halls 194.561 Unit
- Rent 305,52 €

## Child Care

- 9.200 places, 190 facilities
