

COLLOQUE FRANCO-ALLEMAND DEUTSCH-FRANZÖSISCHES KOLLOQUIUM FRANCO-GERMAN SYMPOSIUM

In brief

- 140 participants : a large turnout from Germany (StW and DSW) and France (Crous and Cnous) as well as from Europe (Austria, Belgium, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Czech Republic, Switzerland), Africa (Côte d'Ivoire, Senegal), Quebec and South Korea.
- A rich programme : over 2 days, more than 20 presentations on changes in the student population, student support schemes , housing from a social perspective and health.
- A very positive evaluation from the participants, who noted the richness of the content and the interest of the speakers. The festive events were also appreciated.



Lessons learnt

- Organising this type of event requires a dedicated team with enough time to devote to it.
- The various departments involved should hold regular information and coordination meetings to ensure that tasks are properly allocated.
- Keep the conference separate from other events not aimed at the same audience: organising the prize-giving ceremony for the Franco-German photography competition as part of the conference was not a good idea.
- The European format seems to be a good formula, provided that the programme is designed to meet the interests of each country.
